West Virginia University Collegiate Horsemen's Association is excited to host the **2023 ACHA National Convention on April 12-15, 2023 in wild and wonderful West Virginia**! We have a host of activities planned to expand your knowledge of the horse industry, immerse you in outdoor adventure that our state is known for, and advance your professional skills over a fun four days in Morgantown, WV.

Morgantown is home to WVU and is situated just 75 miles south of Pittsburgh, PA on I-79. If you are traveling by air, your best flight options will be to fly into PIT and rent a passenger van to travel to and around Morgantown. We also have small regional airports in Morgantown (MGW) and Clarksburg (CKB), but flights and rental options will be more limited in those locations.

Lodging accommodations have been secured for the Hampton Inn & Suites at University Town Centre located conveniently off I-79. The hotel is right next door to the Lofts Conference Center that will host our delegates meeting and awards banquet. Included with your block rate is free onsite breakfast each morning. The hotel also has a pool, fitness room and outdoor fire pits.

Because West Virginia's landscape is vast and mountainous traveling across the state to horse industry tour stops would be time intensive, so we decided to bring the horses to you. We will be visiting a local farm and bringing the rest of the horse industry focused demonstrations to the JW Ruby Research Farm, home of our horse unit.

Rental Cars at PIT

Most national rental car agencies are represented at the PIT airport. Check in at rental counters on the Baggage Claim level of the Landside Terminal. It is a short walk to the pick-up and return location in the parking garage. Rental car booking options can be found at the link above.

*We will travel by caravan to the different locations used during national convention so please have a vehicle available for your delegation. Directions will be found in the convention program you will receive at check-in.

It is also close to a variety of fast food stops, restaurants, and stores and is right off I-79 for easy access to travel to all convention locations.

Spring weather in Morgantown will either be sunny, 70 and beautiful or cloudy, 50 and potentially rainy. Bring a variety of warm layers and a good water-resistant jacket. We have indoor spaces planned in case of inclement weather, but you need a variety of attire for a mountain spring!

Choose Your Own Adventure:

During Wild and Wonderful West Virginia Day, we will take part in fun, low ropes team building activities in and among delegations with leaders from Adventure WV. In the afternoon you will be able to choose your own challenge. Please list your top two preferences on the registration form for the following activities: rock climbing, high ropes alpine course, low intensity hike, or hike w/views. The number of students we can accommodate for rock climbing and the high ropes alpine course are limited, and will be granted on a first to register, first serve basis.

Saddlebred Test Ride:

Intermediate to advanced riders are welcome to sign up for a spot for a Saddlebred Test Ride during Saturday's industry tour demos. If you can walk, posting trot, and canter confidently, weigh less than 220 pounds, and want a chance at riding a Saddlebred with instruction from world and national championship level instructors, indicate YES on your registration form. A handful of students will be selected at random for that opportunity during convention.

Things to See and Do:

Visit <u>WV Tourism</u> and <u>Visit Mountaineer Country</u> for ideas about things to see and do in the Mountain State.

Our <u>state</u> and <u>national</u> parks are primo! Coopers Rock State Park is right in our backyard, and if traveling south to go home you could hit New River Gorge National Park & Preserve along the way. West Virginia is rich in natural resources – hiking, kayaking, rafting, rock climbing, fly fishing and other outdoor activities abound for outdoorsmen of all abilities.

If we had to pick one place for you to eat while you are in Morgantown it would be <u>Mountain</u> <u>State Brewing Company</u>. Our picks are any of the wood fired pizzas and don't miss out on the *Almost Heaven* Nachos.

To Attend:

Students must be accompanied by an advisor and are responsible for their own lodging and ground transportation.

Students must be dues paid members of ACHA to attend and compete for individual awards (outstanding student scholarships). Clubs must be dues paid to compete for club awards (scrapbook and philanthropy challenge).
